

Tracking of Provision of Health Care Services

The tracking of the provision of health care services is done with the ChildPlus software program, at the main office in McPherson, and is done for all the centers through that system. Health information is received at the centers, and entered by the Family Advocates into the Child Plus program. The Health Coordinator oversees the health information entered to monitor for program standards compliance.

Family advocates in all centers assist families in obtaining the health services and information, and in follow up on identified health concerns. Child Plus is used in this manner to manage quality assurance in meeting health services goals.
