POLICY:

Early childhood classrooms are permitted to participate in school district's at the end of the year barbecues and picnics as permitted by scheduling.

PROCEDURE:

1. Meals provided by outside clubs & or agencies: These are free meals that are not reimbursable by federal food programs & therefore are not counted in the meals submitted for reimbursement. The children may eat picnic style either in the gym or on the playground dependent on the weather.

2. School sponsored BBQ's provided by home elementary schools food service and generally consists of a hamburger meal which includes the required meal components & amounts of dairy, protein, fruits/vegetables that can be submitted for federal food programs for reimbursement. Meals may be served picnic style either in the gymnasium or on the playground dependent on the weather. Early childhood program pays for each child and 3 staff that participate. Parents may participate but need to sign up and make payment in advance through the school office with their prospective schools and are responsible for their own meal costs.

3. Early Childhood funds will not be responsible for meal costs incurred by additional staff such as; special education teachers, advocates, and special teachers.

4. The Health & Safety Coordinator will work with the registered dietician and food service department to ensure that all special diet needs are met.
